



### Thaden School Community Safety Norms

- Review and update you address and emergency contact information as necessary.
- In the event of a positive result for COVID-19, immediately isolate, notify Thaden’s Point of Contact Pam Chrisco, and cooperate with contact tracing and quarantine efforts as directed by the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH). In the event of close contact with a person or persons (less than six feet apart for at least 15 minutes) with confirmed COVID-19, immediately quarantine, notify Thaden’s Point of Contact Pam Chrisco, and cooperate with contact tracing and quarantine efforts, as directed by the ADH.
- Take responsibility for your own health and the health of others in our community by adhering to guidance from Thaden School, local and state health departments, and federal health authorities.
- Complete a daily pre-screening prior to leaving for school and participate in on-campus screening when arriving on campus.
- Practice consistent preventive measures that include:
  - remaining at least six feet from others whenever possible,
  - wearing a face covering as required by the [Arkansas Governor’s Office](#),
  - washing and sanitizing your hands frequently throughout the day and cleaning your immediate areas in study areas, laboratories and classrooms, and co-curricular facilities as directed,
  - staying home if you are sick and requesting an evaluation and/or testing from your family health provider if you have COVID-19 symptoms such as fever > 100.4°F, sore throat, new uncontrolled cough, loss of taste or smell, new onset of severe headache, diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain,
  - socializing only in small groups and complying with management policies for student groups and organizations,
  - adhering to the [CDC guidelines](#) when traveling outside of the region.

We will not monitor or enforce off-campus compliance with these safety norms, but expect that they will be taken seriously for the benefit of our school and our greater community. All students, families, and employees who elect to return to campus will also receive daily text reminders to complete a pre-screening for COVID-19 symptoms and possible exposure before arriving at school.
